

# ESF Computing Center PC Log on.

Follow these steps to log on to ESF Computing Center PCs:

## 1. Press Ctrl-Alt-Delete.



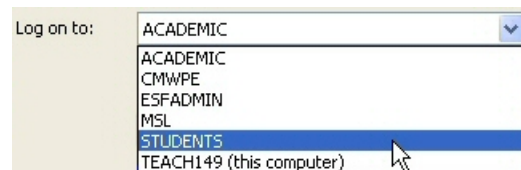
When you see the Windows XP welcome, press the Ctrl-Alt-Delete key combination to begin the log on process. **If you do not see this welcome message when you first sit down at an ESF Computing Center PC, log off the current user or restart the PC before using it.**

## 2. Enter your personal log on information.



Enter your NetID (User name), ESF Password (Password), and select your ESF Domain (Log on to) to log on to the ESF Campus Network. The NetID and ESF Password are the same as those you would use to access your College records on the myESF Web site.

Select your ESF Domain from the 'Log on to' list. Valid ESF Domains for most students are 'STUDENTS' and 'CMWPE.' If you are a Construction Management Wood Products Engineering student, select CMWPE. All other students should use 'STUDENTS.'



## 3. Click 'OK' when all your information is correct and you are ready to log on.



If you need assistance with your personal log on information, please move to a PC that is already logged in and visit the following Web site: <http://cns.esf.edu/MyESF/MyESF.htm>. PCs that are always logged on are available in the center of the main level of Moon Library. Remember to use only your own log on information to access computing or information resources at ESF. Syracuse University students taking classes at ESF should use their SU NetID with an 8-digit password consisting of the following: the last 4 digits of your SSN, the month of your birth (2 digits) and the day of your birth (2 digits).



**Always remember to Log off or Restart a PC when you are finished using it.**
